Medical Coverage

Go-To Transport offers its eligible employees and their families two Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan insurance plans, that they can choose from, that will allow the employee to obtain medical care and services from most any provider they choose. With either one of these plans, any medical service that is preventative is covered 100% by the insurance company.

Prescription Drug Coverage

Go-To Transport offers a prescription drug plan through Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan with a co-pay of \$15 for generic drugs and \$50 for brand name drugs that can be purchased at any pharmacy or through a mail order service.

Dental Coverage

Go-To Transport offers a dental plan administered by Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan that provides coverage for dental visits and procedures with any preventative procedures being covered 100% by the insurance company.

Vision Coverage

Go-To Transport also offers a vision reimbursement program to compliment the Blue Cross/Blue Shield coverage in which the company will reimburse the employee, on a yearly basis, a portion of the cost of the eye exam and glasses/contacts.

401(k) Retirement Plan

Go-To Transport offers its eligible employees the option to participate in the company retirement plan which helps them plan for the future. With this plan the employee is able to set aside a percentage of their earnings prior to the calculation of income taxes. Go-To Transport matches 50 cents of each dollar the employee puts into their retirement plan, up to 5 percent of their total earnings. We can even rollover the balance from your previous plan once you are eligible.

Life Insurance

As an added benefit, Go-To Transport furnishes the employee with a basic life insurance/accidental death policy for all eligible full time employees.

Voluntary Benefits

Eligible employees may also enroll in additional Life Insurance, Disability, Accident Insurance, Critical Illness and various other supplemental Hospital plans through an independent provider the company works in conjunction with.
